From a career that spans over sixty years, Reginald Wickham has continued to create new and refreshing art from his days as a master of classic black and white pictures to the present challenge of digital photography. He remains a leader of technique in his creations. His unique talent is not only that he is an expert technically, but also his eye for beauty is without comparison. He exemplifies photography as an art form.

His work has been published in leading photo magazines, catalogues, brochures, annual reports, and on the cover of record albums, magazines and books. In 1999 Reggie received the “John Dorsher Memorial Award for Excellence in Photography”, one of the highest and most coveted awards the PSA gives. # Upcoming May 3rd Program

## Steve Gottlieb, Horizon Workshops

In 2005, after twenty years as a commercial photographer and author of four photography books ([www.gottliebphoto.com](http://www.gottliebphoto.com)), I turned my attention to creating a photography workshop and teaching photography.

To find a workshop location, I surveyed more than twenty small towns between Washington, D.C. and New York City. Chesapeake City, a waterfront town in northeast Maryland, just ten miles from I-95, seemed the ideal location. The town is filled with colorful, photogenic 19th-century buildings, and it offers wonderful amenities — three lovely B&Bs plus nearby motels, four fine restaurants, a cozy café, and gift shops whose owners are happy to pose for our students. Our classes are held in a historic 1870s building overlooking the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal.

I adopted a weekend workshop format — one, two and three days — because that allows enough time for intensive instruction, without requiring students to make a substantial commitment in time or cost. Horizon workshops emphasize fieldwork because we believe that students learn the most — and have the most fun — when they have extensive opportunity to shoot...with instructors on hand to guide them. Naturally, we also spend time in the classroom where critiques of student work are always a workshop highlight. Class size is limited to guarantee substantial one-on-one contact with instructors. Instructors are chosen based on three qualities: expertise in the subject they teach, passion for photography, and a desire and talent for communicating what they know to students. (Each course page has multiple testimonials with email addresses so you can contact alumni for their impressions.)

As Horizon has flourished, we have expanded beyond Chesapeake City. We offer workshops in NYC, Washington, and Boston. I also lead a one-week “Western Adventure.” We hold about forty weekend workshops annually; you can search for them by subject, location, instructor or date. We also offer custom workshops for camera clubs and meet-up groups (see: <http://www.horizonworkshops.com/groups.html>).
